

**ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE  
CITY OF MARSING  
ORDINANCE A-195**

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2016 APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$2,932,972.00 TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF MARSING FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR, AUTHORIZING A LEVY OF A SUFFICIENT TAX UPON THE TAXABLE PROPERTY AND SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSE FOR WHICH SAID APPROPRIATION IS MADE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSING, OWYHEE COUNTY, IDAHO.

SECTION 1: That the sum of \$2,932,972.00 be, and the same is appropriated to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Marsing, Owyhee County, State of Idaho for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2016.

SECTION 2: The objects and purposes for which such appropriation is made, and the amount of each object and purpose is as follows:

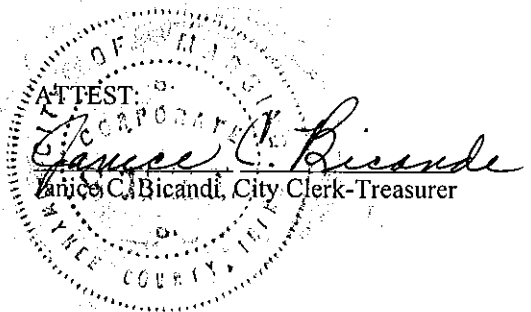



SECTION 4: All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Owyhee Avalanche, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Marsing, and official newspaper of said City.

ORDINANCE NO. A-194

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARSING, IDAHO PROVIDING THAT FAILURE TO OBEY A SIGN IS AN INFRACTION; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City of Marsing has erected signs to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens, and

WHEREAS, the failure to obey municipal signs erected by the City thereby jeopardizes such health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined it is in the best interests of the citizens to provide that the failure to obey a municipal sign is a violation of the Marsing City Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSING, IDAHO:


Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to fail to obey a sign erected by any Idaho political subdivision or the State of Idaho within the City of Marsing.


Section 2: The penalty for violation of this Ordinance shall be an infraction and shall be punished by a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00), which does not include court costs.


Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper of the City.






Section 1: Marsing City Code Title 1 through Title 5, is hereby established.



WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. A82A, enacted in 1983, the City Council created a planning zoning commission;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. A82A, enacted in 1983, the City Council established duties of the planning and zoning commission;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to disband the planning and zoning commission and repeal its enactment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSING, OWYHEE COUNTY; IDAHO:


**SECTION 1:** That Ordinance No. A82A is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 2:** The City Council shall exercise its sole planning and zoning powers as set forth under Idaho Code Section 67-6504.





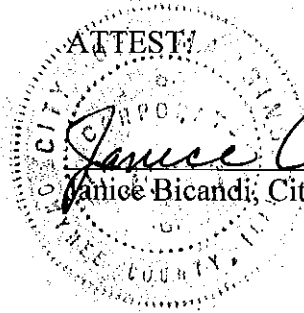
Section 1: Provides for the repeal of Ordinance No. A82A of the Marsing Municipal Code.




Section 1: The attached map, heretofore attached and labeled as Exhibit A to this Ordinance is hereby adopted.

Section 2: All previous land use zoning maps which conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.



