

**CITY OF MARSING
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
SPECIAL MEETING
OCTOBER 3, 2018
6:00 PM**

Mayor James Ferdinand called the special meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

The purpose of the Special Council Meeting was to approve the bid for Reich Street Rehabilitation Project.

Roll call: Mayor James Ferdinand, Councilman Jolyn Green, Councilman Marie Herman, Councilman Tony Malmberg, City Clerk/Treasurer Janice Bicandi and Kirby Cook from Civil Dynamics were present. Councilman Chris Even was absent.


Engineer Kirby Cook reported that the bid opening for Reich Street Rehabilitation was held on September 28, 2018 at 4:00 p.m. Thueson Construction Inc. was the only bid. Their bid was \$121,037.00. The grant was for \$100,000 from LHTAC. The City of Marsing is responsible for the remaining \$21,037.00. The project starts at the intersection and ends ten feet past the culvert. The project will begin on October 22nd.

According to Cook, Jesse Geary with Thueson Construction believes he might save the City \$6,000.00 in traffic control as when they bid the project, they used an old bid. In the bid plans, Cook had put a squash pipe in the culvert in order to get enough depth. Geary thinks a regular culvert could be used which would save an additional \$9,500.00.

Councilman Tony Malmberg moved and Jolyn Green seconded to approve the bid from Thueson Construction Inc. for \$121,037.00 for the Reich Street Rehabilitation Project and for the Mayor to sign the Notice of Award to Thueson Construction Inc. The Mayor asked all Councilmen in favor to say aye with all Councilmen present voting aye. Motion carried.

Councilman Jolyn Green moved and Marie Herman seconded to adjourn the meeting at 6:17 p.m. The Mayor asked all Councilmen in favor to say aye with all Councilmen present voting aye. Motion carried.
