

RESOLUTION NO. 145

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSING, IDAHO RELATING TO SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY; DECLARING CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE CITY TO BE SURPLUS; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DISPOSAL OF THE SURPLUS PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marsing, Idaho ("City") has acquired certain personal property for the purpose of carrying out services in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, certain items of personal property of the City have become worn out, obsolete, or are no longer needed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City has deemed it unnecessary to maintain ownership of surplus personal property of the City specifically, a Honda generator; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City desires to dispose of the Honda generator as allowed by State law.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marsing, Idaho as follows:

Section 1: The City Council finds and declares that the City no longer has a use for the Honda generator ("surplus property").

Section 2: The City Clerk is authorized and directed to sell the surplus property to the highest bidder after public notice.

Section 3: The City Clerk is authorized to donate the surplus property if the bids on the surplus property are not in the best interest of the City, if no bids are received, or in the event that surplus property has no saleable value because of condition, obsolescence, or if the surplus property is inappropriate for use by the public.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
